MATURE SIZE:	15–25' h x 10–20' w
NATURAL BLOOM SEASON:	Spring through summer
USDA HARDINESS:	Zone 5
USES:	Containers, mass plantings, low water, coastal sites

MEDIA:	Standard Ornamental Nursery Mix
MEDIA PH:	5.5–6.0
MEDIA EC:	1.0–1.5
MOISTURE:	Maintain even moisture in well drained soil.
FERTILIZER:	13-5-9 Harrell's 8–9 month slow release feed, top dressed <ul style="list-style-type: none">• 20 grams in 1 gallon• 40 grams in 2 gallon• 60 grams in 3 gallon
COMMON PESTS & DISEASE:	Monitor for aphids on soft new growth.
TRIMMING:	Recommend one trim minimum during the first year of production to bulk. Height may be controlled by trims. Chilopsis does well as a hedging shrub or trained into a tree.
PGRS:	None needed
FINISHING TIMES:	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Shift Tree Shifter liner in Spring. Plants will be saleable the following spring.
