NATURAL BLOOM SEASON: Spring through summer

**USES:** Containers, mass plantings, low water,

coastal sites

COMMON PESTS & DISEASE: Monitor for aphids on soft new growth.

TRIMMING: Recommend one trim minimum during

the first year of production to bulk. Height may be controlled by trims. Chilopsis does well as a hedging shrub
