DROUGHT TOLERANT VARIETIES

For climates with high temperatures and limited water, these drought tolerant varieties will serve your customers well.



Acacia Cousin Itt
Acacia cognata 'ACCOG01' PP 25,133'

Evergreen shrub with a compact, mounded, spreading habit and beautiful, soft emerald green, weeping foliage. Low water requirements make it great for dry landscapes or as a container plant for colder, wetter climates. High tolerance of heat in the Southwest.



Brick House™
'Meiraligh' PP 30,141

Brick House™ offers excellent, dark red flower color and a strong re-bloom throughout the season. It has superior disease resistance and performs well on its own roots. Blue Ribbon™ Winner for outstanding, low water performance in 2017–2019 WUCOLS trials.



Coral Drift®
'Meidrifora' PP 19,148 CPBR 4,871

Bright, coral-orange blooms cover this small, mounding shrub from mid-spring to mid-fall. The rose has vibrant eye-catching coral flowers. Fully winter hardy and disease resistant, as well as heat and drought tolerant.



Double Knock Out®
'Radtko' PP 16,202 CPBR 3,104

The full, double flowers look just like a classic rose. It is as resistant to black spot as the famous original, has the same bloom cycle and is slightly more winter hardy. Blue Ribbon™ Winner for outstanding, low water performance in 2016–2018 WUCOLS trials.



Grevillea 'Kings Celebration'
Grevillea hybrid 'Kings Celebration' PP 27,899

This variety blooms year-round in Southern California. A great looking plant in the garden and can be used as a screen or alone in the landscape. The multicolored flowers are striking and attractive to hummingbirds and bees.



Grevillea 'Kings Fire'
Grevillea hybrid 'Kings Fire' PP 27,875

This variety has exotic looking blooms that flower year-round in Southern California. It's tough, durable, drought tolerant and has lots of textured color. 'Kings Fire' does great in containers or in the landscape. Blue Ribbon™ Winner for outstanding, low water performance in 2018–2020 WUCOLS trials.



Grevillea 'Kings Rainbow'
Grevillea hybrid 'Kings Rainbow' PP 27,931

This variety has exotic looking blooms that flower year-round in Southern California. It's sturdy, drought tolerant and has a colorful texture. 'Kings Rainbow' grows well in containers or in the landscape and is a favorite of hummingbirds.



Grevillea 'Peaches and Cream'
Grevillea hybrid 'Peaches and Cream' PP 18,035

This shrub has a dense, spreading habit and attractive bright green, deeply dissected foliage with long, loose flower clusters of peach and cream year-round. This is a great looking plant in a container or in the landscape. The beautiful, multicolored, and long lasting flowers are attractive to hummingbirds and bees.



Grevillea 'Spirit of Anzac'
Grevillea hybrid 'Spirit of Anzac' PP 29,372

This is a low maintenance shrub that thrives in full sun and heat with low water requirements. Its bright red flowers contrast nicely against its silver-green foliage and are a favorite stop for hummingbirds. Evergreen foliage and a long bloom window.



Icecap™
'Meiradena' PP 26,790

Icecap™ displays a dense flush of pure white flowers on a compact, rounded shrub. It has excellent repeat-blooming and disease resistance, and it has been one of the most consistent performers in our independent trials. Blue Ribbon™ Winner for outstanding, low water performance in 2018–2020 WUCOLS trials.



Kardinal Kolorscape®
'Korsixkono' PP 23,548

This variety features brilliant red flowers that hold their color without fading. A very prolific bloomer with glossy, green foliage that thrives in hot summers. Easy to grow and exceptionally disease tolerant. Blue Ribbon™ Winner for outstanding, low water performance in WUCOLS trials.



Knock Out®
'Radrazz'

The original member of The Knock Out® Family, this shrub rose set a new standard in disease resistance with little to no maintenance required. It continually produces cherry red, hot pink blooms. Black spot resistant, drought-tolerant and self-cleaning.



Leucodendron 'Ebony'

Leucodendron hybrid 'Ebony' PP 23,258

Lustrous, blackish-burgundy foliage and burgundy red bracts surround the flowers from late winter to summer. The dark foliage of 'Ebony' makes a great specimen plant in the garden or in a large container. Great for cut flower use and is drought-tolerant once established.



Limoncello™

'Meijeycka' PP 21,532

This vigorously growing Landscape Shrub Rose almost always displays a profusion of light yellow flowers. Limoncello™ blooms perpetually throughout the season. It can be grown in large landscapes or used in mass plantings. Blue Ribbon™ Winner for outstanding, low water performance in 2017–2019 WUCOLS trials.



Lomandra Lime Tough

Lomandra confertifolia ssp rubiginosa 'Lomlon' PP 23,034

This is a tough plant in the landscape, enduring times of frost and hot, dry conditions, as well as full sun or shade. The lime green foliage stays lush year-round, and this variety requires little to no maintenance.



Lomandra 'Seascape'

Lomandra confertifolia ssp rubiginosa 'Seascape' PP 20,010

The unique, airy, weeping habit of this blue-green Lomandra makes it a great choice for borders, mass plantings or spilling over the edge of retaining walls and containers. Featuring durability, great landscape, textural interest, no maintenance and drought-tolerance—this variety is a versatile choice.



Peachy Knock Out®

'Radgor' PP 25,628

Blooms from spring through fall with attractive pink flowers. The overall color effect is peach, achieved with the combination of pink petals that become yellow in the center. The color will be much more intense with the cooler temperatures in the spring and fall.



Pink Drift®

'Meijocos' PP 18,874 CPBR 4,874

Pink Drift® is low-growing with distinctive, mounded flowers. Deep pink flowers with a soft, faded center bloom in abundance throughout the season. This disease resistant plant is easy to care for and combines well with other plants.



Pink Knock Out®

'Radcon' PP 15,070 CPBR 2,044

Single petals, just like the original, but in a beautiful shade of bright pink! Like the other members of the family, Pink Knock Out® is black spot resistant, drought-tolerant and self-cleaning. A perfect companion to other shrubs, roses and perennials. Blue Ribbon™ Winner for outstanding, low water performance in 2017–2019 WUCOLS trials.



Red Drift®

'Meigalpio' PP 17,877 CPBR 4,872

Red Drift® has great flower power and disease resistance. It's perfect for use in front of border plantings. It makes a beautiful statement when it drapes naturally over a rock wall or edge.



Raphiolepis Oriental Pearl

Raphiolepis indica 'Parhap' PP 20,243

Masses of large, white blooms appear in the spring on this low-growing, drought-tolerant plant. It requires no pruning and is not fussy about soils, making it a must-have for any low-maintenance landscape.



White Drift®

'Meizorland' PP 28,054 CPBR 5,592

White Drift® has pure white, fully double blooms. It has a true groundcover habit, with the superior disease resistance you would expect from a Drift® Rose. It makes a beautiful addition to the landscape. Blue Ribbon™ Winner for outstanding, low water performance in 2016–2018 WUCOLS trials.



White Knock Out®

'Radwhite' PP 20,273

An excellent shrub rose that stands out in the landscape due to the contrast between pure white blooms and very dark green foliage. It blooms from spring through fall, maintaining a compact habit. Blue Ribbon™ Winner for outstanding, low water performance in 2017–2019 WUCOLS trials.
