Berberis Midnight Ruby Berberis thunbergii 'Midruzam' PP 25,609

Berberis Midnight Ruby is similar in size to the popular Berberis 24K Gold. This dense and dwarf barberry produces elegant burgundy foliage that turns dark red in the fall. It makes an excellent accent plant or low hedge. This variety does not flower or produce fruit



Head Over Heels<sup>®</sup> Blush Hibiscus *Hibiscus moscheutos* 'RutHib1' PP 30,824

Graceful, blush pink blooms are plentiful on this beautiful Hibiscus. The contrast between the bright flowers and dark burgundy foliage creates an eye-catching experience. This series displays exceptionally large flowers in a range of vivid colors.



Berberis 'Red Torch' Berberis thunbergii PP 22,220

This Metasequoia is a deciduous conifer with bright golden foliage that emerges in the spring and becomes an outstanding amber color as the season progresses. Foliage does not burn even in full sun.



Fire Chief<sup>™</sup> Thuja *Thuja occidentalis* 'Congabe' PP 19,009

Fire Chief<sup>™</sup> is a mutation of the popular Rheingold variety, but with much brighter foliage in the spring and a deeper red color in the fall. This variety is also less prone to splitting.



Pistachio™ Hydrangea Hydrangea macrophylla 'Horwack' PP 25,577

Pistachio<sup>™</sup> displays mindblowing petal colors of lime green accented by deep pink. This unique, re-blooming mophead flowers from late spring to fall and is a wonderful garden centerpiece.



Nandina 'Tuscan Flame' *Nandina domestica* 'Tuscan Flame' PP 21,940

This compact evergreen puts on a flaming show of color! New growth emerges a striking red that lasts through most of the season before aging to an attractive dark green. A drought-tolerant and low-maintenance selection.

This pink Vitex is very well behaved in the landscape. The shrub stays dense and blooms with long, bright spikes of pink flowers in late summer. It is an excellent shrub to add late season color to the garden after spring and summer flowering plants have faded. In colder climates, it will re-flush from the roots.
