Apple Perfection[™] Abelia *Abelia hybrid* '00-bc-47-7r' PPAF

Apple Perfection[™] is uniformly mounded and rarely throws whips, resulting in less needed trimming. It produces an abundance of pure white flowers over extremely glossy green foliage.



Peach Perfection[®] Abelia Abelia hybrid 'SRPabeper' PP 30,954

Peach Perfection[®] displays attractive tricolor foliage on stunning red stems. New growth emerges bright orange, eventually turning to yellow and green as it ages. The yellow foliage holds up well in the sun and heat. This plant will maintain a compact, rounded habit.



Raspberry Perfection[™] Abelia

Abelia chinensis 'Abesrpras' PP 33,516

Raspberry Perfection[™] is a compact plant that rarely throws whips, resulting in less needed trimming. It is a very heavy bloomer with dark pink sepals that persist after flowers have passed, extending its color interest.



Straight A[®] 'Barley Blue' Agapanthus Agapanthus praecox 'Barley Blue'

Add early color interest to your garden with Straight A° 'Barley Blue'. This early bloomer will enchant the garden with its light blue flowers and strong stems. Its compact habit makes it a great accent or filler plant for the garden border or mixed container.



Straight A[®] 'Blue Bayou' Agapanthus *Agapanthus praecox* 'Blue Bayou' PP 26,420

RoyalRazz^{*} is one of the brightest purple Buddleia on the market. The excellent color and long bloom window guarantee garden interest from spring through mid-fall. Its large panicles of flowers attract butterflies.



True Blue[™] Buddleia Buddleia hybrid 'Bostulu' PP 25,708

This Buddleia produces gorgeous flowers as true to blue as the market has seen. Strong stems and an upright habit make this variety great for borders, embankments, and landscape plantings, as well as use in mixed containers. It is a continuous bloomer from summer until frost and will attract butterflies.



Summer Jazz™ Fire Campsis Campsis x tagliabuana 'Takarazuka Fresa' PP 23,917

The bright red-orange flowers on this compact trumpet vine make a fiery statement on a small trellis or fence. Hummingbirds and butterflies are naturally drawn to the bloom shape and color. Winner of the Gold Medal for "Best New Plant" at 2014 Plantarium.



Summer Jazz™ Sunrise Gold Campsis *Campsis x tagliabuana* 'Takarazuka Yellow' PP 23.918

Large flowers open peach-orange and mature to yellow with orange-red throats and red veining. The Summer Jazz[™] series is compact with a tamer, more restrained growth rate than other trumpet vine varieties, making it ideal for a small trellis or fence. Also great for attracting hummingbirds and butterflies!



Carolina Sweetheart[®] Cercis Cercis canadensis 'NCCC1' PP 27,712

Carolina Sweetheart[®] has attractive, variegated foliage. Rich maroon leaves unfurl in early spring, eventually becoming green with white margins. It maintains the elegant, broad, heartshaped leaves expected of redbud trees. Cercis is a genus native to Eastern North America. A result of the combined efforts of NCNLA and NC State University.



Flame Thrower[®] Cercis Cercis canadensis 'NC2016-2' PP 31,260

This Cercis will take your breath away! New growth emerges burgundy red, followed by bright yellow and green as it ages. The color display is persistent throughout the season, often showing four to five different shades on a single branch. Developed by the JC Raulston Arboretum at NC State University.



Golden Falls[®] Cercis Cercis canadensis 'NC2015-12' PP 31,658

Golden Falls[®] offers a breakthrough foliage color for a weeping Cercis. In spring, new growth is tinged with orange, followed by bright gold leaves that hold up well in the sun and heat. The narrow, weeping architecture of this variety lends itself well to small garden spaces. Developed by the JC Raulston Arboretum at NC State University.



Cercis 'Pink Pom Poms' Cercis canadensis 'Pink Pom Poms' PP 27,630

Fully double, pink flower clusters emerge in the spring followed by large, heart-shaped green foliage. 'Pink Pom Poms' is a female, sterile variety that does not produce seed pods. Developed by the JC Raulston Arboretum at NC State University.



Chilopsis 'Sweet Bubba' Chilopsis linearis 'Sweet Bubba' PP 33,091

'Sweet Bubba' is a low-maintenance tree that thrives in dry, low-water climates. It displays eye-catching, magenta flowers that are much larger than other Chilopsis varieties. The blooms are fragrant and enduring.



Grevillea 'Kings Celebration' *Grevillea hybrid* 'Kings Celebration' PP 27,899

This variety blooms year-round in southern California bringing color to the garden. Especially effective when used as a screen or alone in the landscape. The multicolored flowers are striking and attractive to hummingbirds and bees.



Grevillea 'Kings Fire' Grevillea hybrid 'Kings Fire' PP 27,875

This variety has exotic blooms that flower year-round in southern California. It's tough, durable, and drought tolerant with lots of textured color. 'Kings Fire' performs well in containers or in the landscape and is a favorite of hummingbirds. Blue Ribbon™ Winner for outstanding, low water performance in 2017-2019 WUCOLS trials.



Grevillea 'Kings Rainbow' Grevillea hybrid 'Kings Rainbow' PP 27,931

This variety has exotic blooms that flower year-round in southern California. It's sturdy, drought tolerant, and offers striking colorful texture. 'Kings Rainbow' grows well in containers or in the landscape and is a favorite of hummingbirds.



Grevillea 'Kings Sunrise' Grevillea hybrid 'Kings Sunrise' PP 33,941

'Kings Sunrise' produces rich orange blooms against finely textured foliage. With low water requirements and an ability to thrive in high heat and sun, this plant is extremely low maintenance with high reward. Its flowers are a favorite stop for hummingbirds.



Grevillea 'Peaches and Cream' *Grevillea hybrid* 'Peaches and Cream' PP 18,035

This shrub has a dense, spreading habit and attractive, bright green, deeply dissected foliage. Long, loose flower clusters of peach and cream bloom yearround. It is attractive when planted in a container or in the landscape. The multicolored, long-lasting flowers are attractive to hummingbirds and bees.



Grevillea 'Spirit of Anzac' Grevillea hybrid 'Spirit of Anzac' PP 29,372

This low-maintenance evergreen shrub thrives in full sun and heat with low water requirements. Silver-green foliage is a wonderful contrast to the bright red flowers that fill a long bloom window and are a favorite stop for hummingbirds.



Head Over Heels® Adore[™] Hibiscus Hibiscus moscheutos 'RutHib3' PP 32,883

This Hibiscus offers a bright burst of color on a petite plant. The large, pink flowers open slightly later than other varieties in the series, extending the window of color into the fall season. 'San Antonio Rose' displays large, bright pink flowers in abundance throughout the summer. Its bold blooms and silver-green foliage make an eye-catching planting in the garden. This variety produces larger flowers than other Leucophyllum.



Lagerstroemia Enduring Lavender Lagerstroemia indica 'PIILAG B4' PP 25,195

A re-blooming, dwarf series brought to you by Dr. Michael Dirr. This variety blooms early and all summer long. It is tolerant of both heat and drought, deer resistant, and makes an excellent accent or container plant.



Leucospermum Royal Hawaiian 'Blanche Ito' *Leucospermum* × 'Blanche Ito'

This evergreen shrub boasts upright stems to support its lance-shaped, two-inch long leaves. Blooms emerge at branch tips as yellow pincushions and age to red for a dramatic statement in the landscape and in containers. Wonderful for use as a cut flower with a vase life of about 16 days.



Peaches and Cream[™] Lonicera

Lonicera periclymenum 'Inov86' PP 21,839

Peaches and Cream[™] Lonicera has a compact habit that is suitable for a trellis or a groundcover. Its beautiful, deep magenta buds open to a burst of fragrant pink and white, bicolored flowers. Flowering occurs from late spring until fall. This variety is loved by hummingbirds!



Purple Plunge[®] Prunus Prunus cerasifera 'NCPR-7' PP 32,190

Purple Plunge* has a unique pendulous, branching habit, which gives it a graceful, weeping growth form. This small tree has large and fragrant blush pink flowers in its second year. This Prunus has not produced fruit in 10 years of observation. Developed by the JC Raulston Arboretum at NC State University.



Ruby Ruffle[®] Prunus Prunus persica 'NC Peach-6' PP 34,261

Ruby Ruffle* Patio Peach gets its name from the ruffled appearance of its leaves and petals. A heavier bloomer than other varieties on the market, this small tree flushes with semi-double dark pink flowers every spring and presents dark burgundy foliage that reliably retains its color. The wellbehaved habit is ideal for small gardens and decorative containers.



Black Tower[™] Sambucus Sambucus nigra 'Eiffel 1' PP 23,633

With a strong, upright growth habit and intense burgundy-black foliage, Black Tower[™] creates a beautiful contrast with other plants in the landscape. The soft and airy texture of its foliage is reminiscent of a Japanese maple. Two-tone pink flowers bloom in summer followed by purple berries in the fall.



Empire[®] Ice Dragon[™] Spiraea *Spiraea japonica* 'Iceconspir' PP 33,786

Empire[®] Ice Dragon[™] displays attractive foliage on a compact habit. New growth emerges a deep burgundy against blue-green, older foliage for a striking contrast. Pink flowers start in late spring and sporadically re-bloom throughout the season.



Golden Tower[™] Sambucus Sambucus nigra 'Jandeboer001' PP 28,957

Golden Tower[™] is a unique elderberry variety. Its shimmering golden, lacy leaves truly stand out in the garden. This variety is reminiscent of a Japanese maple and its dense, columnar habit makes it an ideal focal plant in the landscape. Beautiful white flower clusters are produced in spring, followed by bunches of red berries.



Fandango[®] Blue Scaevola *Scaevola crassifolia* 'Luedansca' PPAF

Looking for true blue flowers? Look no further! Fandango[®] Blue produces an abundance of fan-shaped blue flowers on a dense, rounded shrub. This variety is quick-growing and drought tolerant.



Sphaeralcea 'Orange Crush' Sphaeralcea ambigua 'Orange Crush' PP 34,220

'Orange Crush' produces an abundance of orange flowers from late December through June. An ideal selection for dry, low-water areas. This shrub thrives in both the landscape and containers.



Empire[®] Northern Lights[™] Spiraea Spiraea japonica 'DAVCOP01' PP 31,996

Empire[®] Northern Lights[™] shows off a brilliant display of three colors on one plant. New growth emerges bright red before aging to yellow and then to light green. Foliage colors are most intense in spring and fall. Pink flowers appear in late spring and sporadically re-bloom throughout the season.



Empire® Yeti™ Spiraea Spiraea japonica 'Conspiyet' PP 28,999

Empire[®] Yeti[™] is a compact Spiraea variety. This special plant produces many clusters of small white flowers that will re-bloom from a trim. It is also self-cleaning, maintaining a clean look throughout the season. Expect it to maintain a low, mounding habit in the landscape. An extremely hardy selection.



Tecoma 'Red Hot' Tecoma hybrid 'Red Hot' PPAF

Tecoma 'Red Hot' has drought tolerance, a compact habit, and unique flower color. Flowers open crimson red and age to intense orange with a yellow center. The trumpet-shaped blooms are lightly fragrant and attract hummingbirds.



Riot Red[®] Tecomaria Tecomaria capensis

Riot Red[®] cape honeysuckle produces a red flower that is double the size of other Tecomarias on the market. The flower color on this variety is true red, not the common scarlet red color. It is an evergreen with lush foliage and a long bloom window, making this shrubby vine a real standout.
