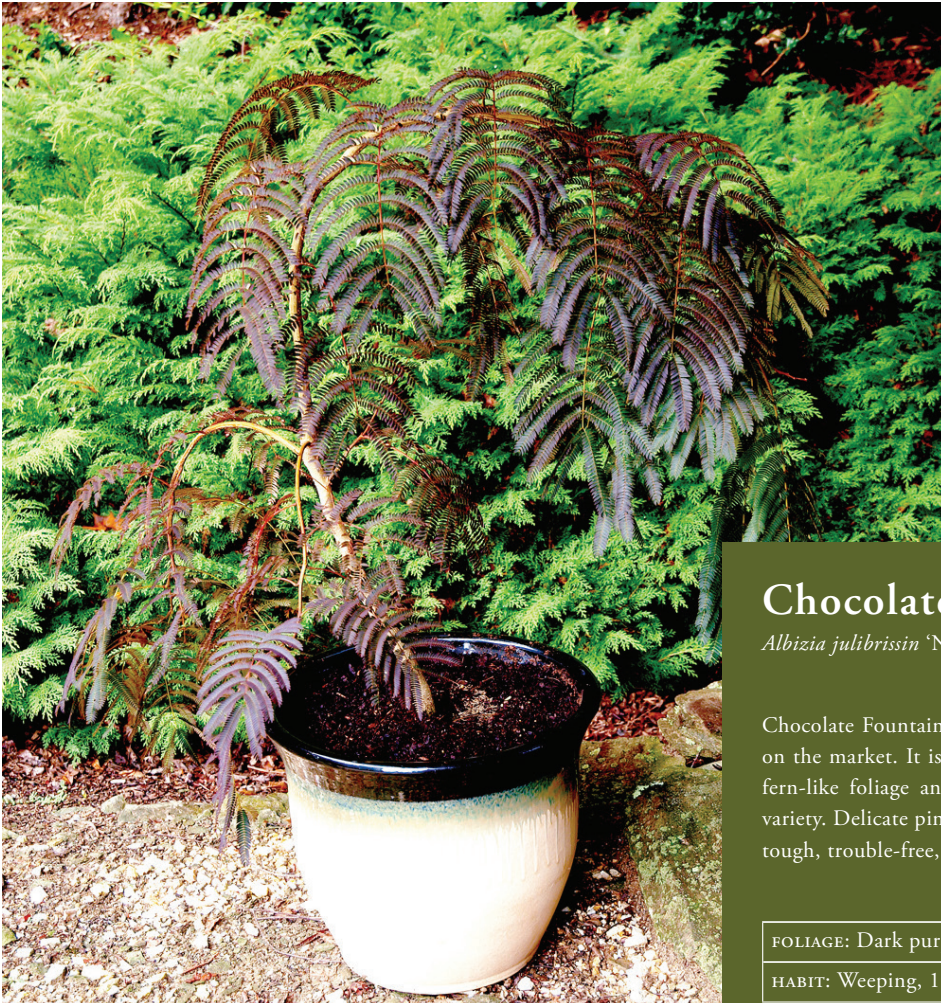

Chocolate Fountain® Albizia

Albizia julibrissin 'NCAJ1' PP 25,813

Chocolate Fountain® is the only weeping silk tree with purple foliage on the market. It is well adapted to smaller spaces or containers. The fern-like foliage and pendulous, weeping habit make this a unique variety. Delicate pink flowers form in the summer. This Albizia is tough, trouble-free, and drought-resistant in the landscape.

FOLIAGE: Dark purple

FLOWER: Pink

HABIT: Weeping, 15–20' h x up to 15' w

ZONES: 6–10



Albizia 'Summer Chocolate'

Albizia julibrissin 'Summer Chocolate'

'Summer Chocolate' is a beautiful deciduous tree with a lovely arching habit and umbrella canopy. The fern-like, compound foliage starts green and changes to a rich chocolate burgundy by summer. Fragrant, pink pincushion flowers appear in summer and contrast nicely against the vibrant foliage.

FOLIAGE: Rich chocolate burgundy

FLOWER: Pink

HABIT: Upright, 15–20' h x 20' w

ZONES: 6b–10



Carolina Sweetheart® Cercis

Cercis canadensis 'NCCC1' PP 27,712

Carolina Sweetheart® has attractive, variegated foliage. Rich maroon leaves unfurl in early spring, eventually becoming green with white margins. It maintains the elegant, broad, heart-shaped leaves expected of redbud trees. *Cercis* is a genus native to Eastern North America. A result of the combined efforts of NCNLA and NC State University. Bronze medal winner in New Plants Competition at Plantarium Trade Show, August 2019.

FOLIAGE: Green, white and pink

FLOWER: Light pink

HABIT: Small tree, 20–30' h x 30' w

ZONES: 5–9



Golden Falls® Cercis

Cercis canadensis 'NC2015-12' PP 31,658

Golden Falls® offers a breakthrough foliage color for a weeping Cercis. In spring, new growth is tinged with orange, followed by bright gold leaves that hold up well in the sun and heat. The narrow, weeping architecture of this variety lends itself well to small garden spaces. Developed by the JC Raulston Arboretum at NC State University.

FOLIAGE: Golden yellow to lime green

FLOWER: Pink

HABIT: Weeping tree, 8–10' h x 3–4' w

ZONES: 5–9

This highly impressive redbud boasts perfectly pink flowers and show-stopping foliage that emerges burgundy-red and turns bright yellow and green as it ages. Stunning color display is persistent throughout the season, often showing four to five different shades on a single branch! Developed by the JC Raulston Arboretum at NC State University.

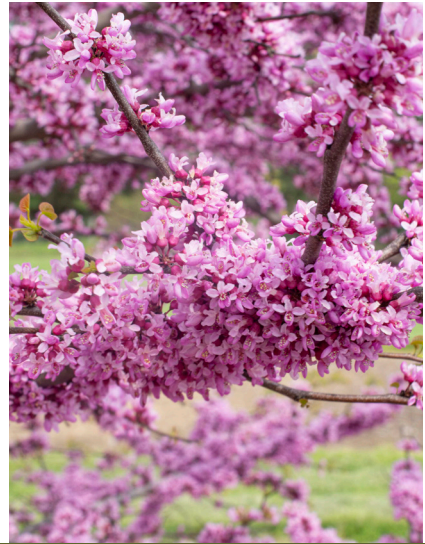
Garden Gems™ Amethyst Cercis

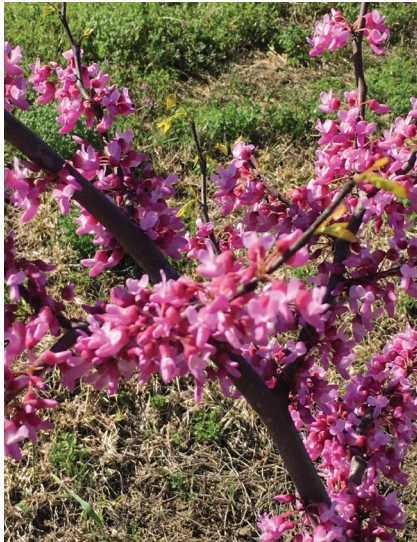
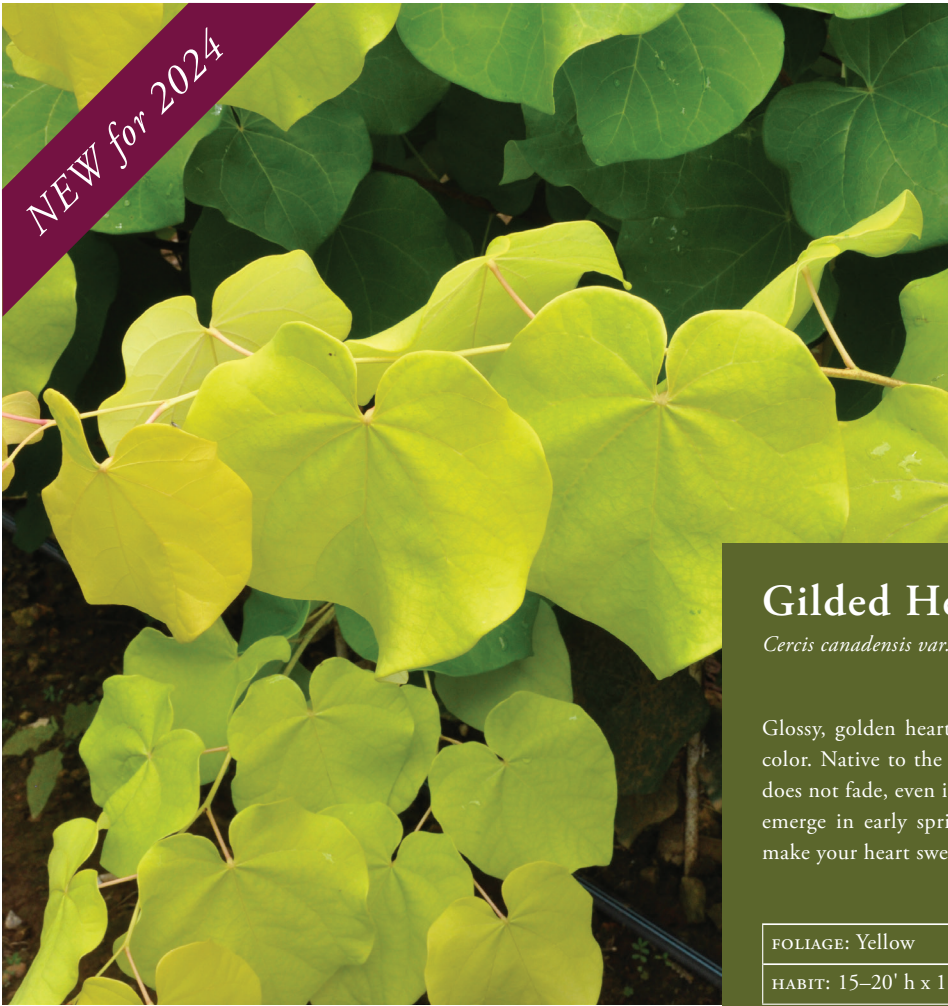
Garden Gems™ Emerald Cercis

Gilded Hearts™ Cercis

Cercis canadensis var. *texensis* 'NC2014-10' PPAF



Glossy, golden heart-shaped leaves cover this small tree with vibrant color. Native to the Southwestern United States and Texas, its foliage does not fade, even in direct sun and high heat. Masses of pink flowers emerge in early spring, adding beautiful color and texture that will make your heart swell!

FOLIAGE: Yellow	FLOWER: Pink
HABIT: 15–20' h x 15–20' w	ZONES: 6–9



Cercis 'Pink Pom Poms'

Cercis canadensis 'Pink Pom Poms' PP 27,630



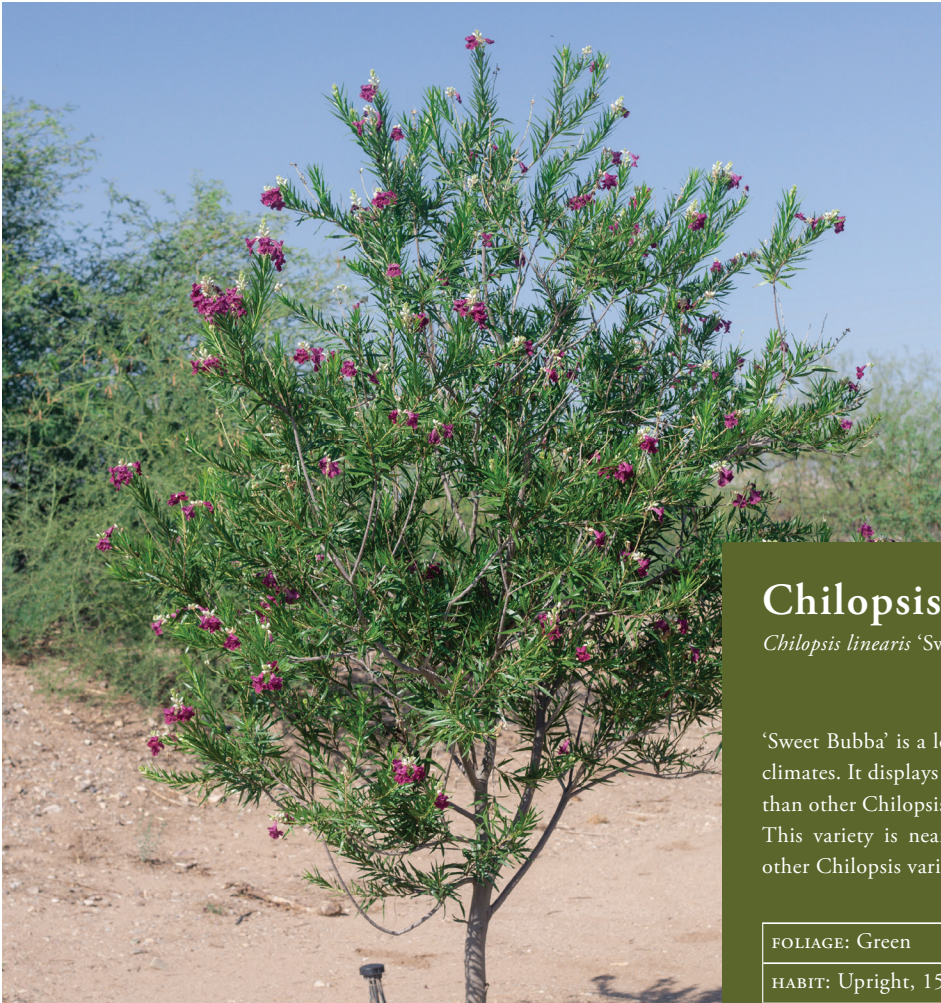
Fully double, pink flower clusters emerge in the spring followed by large, heart-shaped green foliage. 'Pink Pom Poms' is a female, sterile variety that does not produce seed pods. Developed by the JC Raulston Arboretum at NC State University.

FOLIAGE: Green

FLOWER: Pink

HABIT: Medium tree, 12½' h x 12' w
(at 8 years of age)

ZONES: 5-9



Chilopsis 'Sweet Bubba'

Chilopsis linearis 'Sweet Bubba' PPAF

'Sweet Bubba' is a low-maintenance tree that thrives in dry, low-water climates. It displays eye-catching, magenta flowers that are much larger than other *Chilopsis* varieties. Flowers are fragrant and long-blooming. This variety is nearly seedless, providing a cleaner appearance than other *Chilopsis* varieties.

FOLIAGE: Green

FLOWER: Magenta

HABIT: Upright, 15–25' h x 10–20' w

ZONES: 7–11

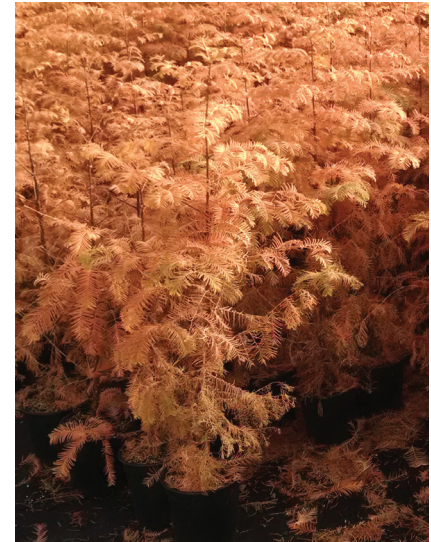
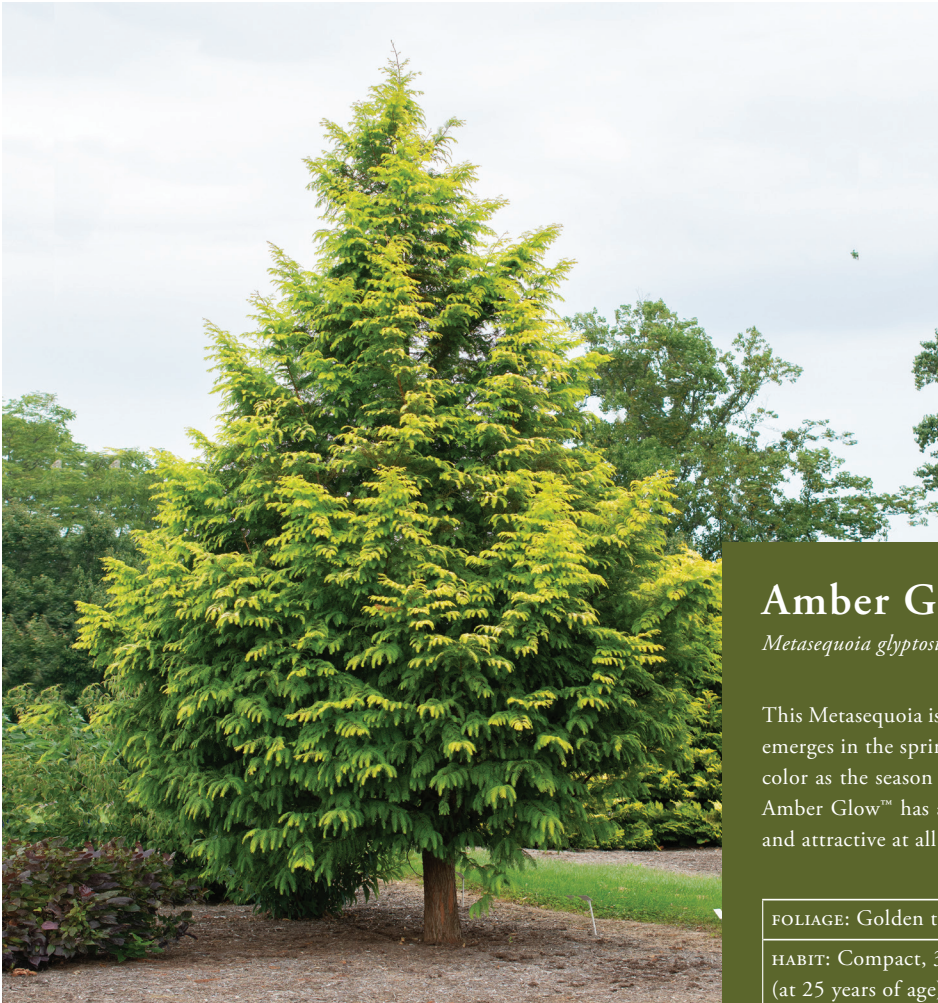


Bonsai Blue™ Jacaranda

Jacaranda spp. mimosifolia Bonsai Blue 'Sakai01' PP 26,574

This truly dwarf plant blooms with vibrant purple flowers in late spring to early summer. Bonsai Blue™ is an ideal specimen tree with bright green, tropical, fern-like foliage that is perfect for the small garden or in a patio container.

FOLIAGE: Bright green	FLOWER: Purple
HABIT: 6–8' h x 5' w	ZONES: 9–11



Amber Glow™ Metasequoia

Metasequoia glyptostroboides 'WAH-08AG' PP 29,472

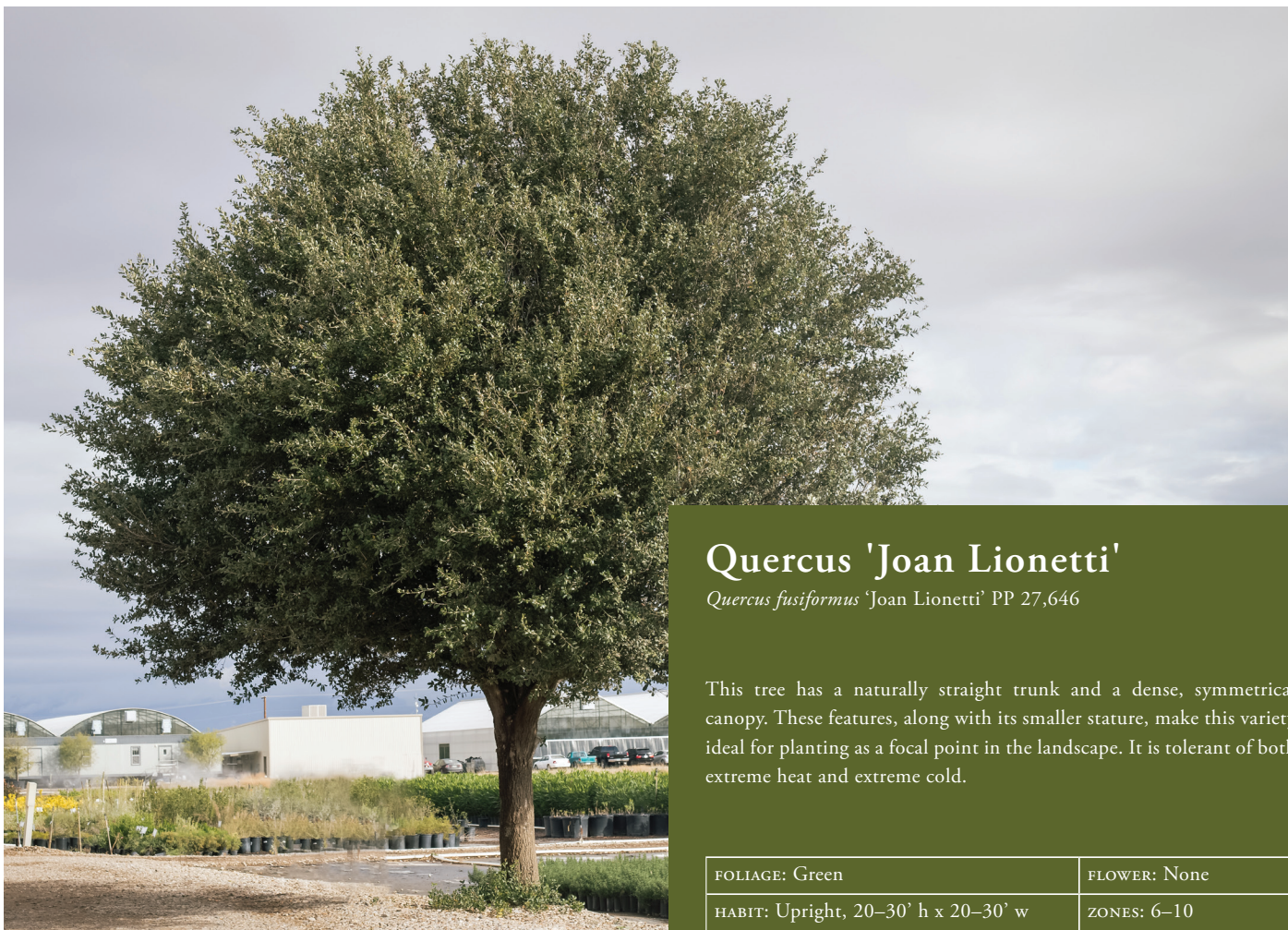
This Metasequoia is a deciduous conifer with bright golden foliage that emerges in the spring and becomes an outstanding amber color as the season progresses. Foliage does not burn even in full sun. Amber Glow™ has a dense, pyramidal habit that remains symmetrical and attractive at all stages of production.

FOLIAGE: Golden tinged with orange

FLOWER: None

HABIT: Compact, 30–35' h
(at 25 years of age)

ZONES: 5–10



Quercus 'Joan Lionetti'

Quercus fusiformis 'Joan Lionetti' PP 27,646

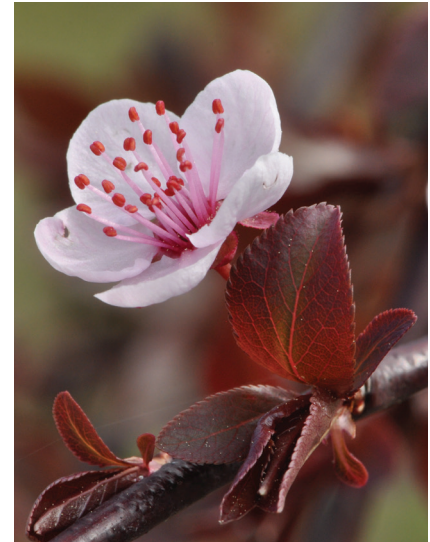
This tree has a naturally straight trunk and a dense, symmetrical canopy. These features, along with its smaller stature, make this variety ideal for planting as a focal point in the landscape. It is tolerant of both extreme heat and extreme cold.

FOLIAGE: Green

FLOWER: None

HABIT: Upright, 20–30' h x 20–30' w

ZONES: 6–10



Purple Plunge® Prunus

Prunus cerasifera 'NCPR-7' PP 32,190

Purple Plunge® has a unique pendulous, branching habit, which gives it a graceful, weeping growth form. This small tree has large and fragrant blush pink flowers in its second year. This Prunus has not produced fruit in 10 years of observation. It is quick-growing and adaptable to a wide variety of environments. Developed by the JC Raulston Arboretum at NC State University.

FOLIAGE: Burgundy

FLOWER: Blush pink

HABIT: Small weeping tree, 7–10' h x 3–4' w

ZONES: 5–9



Ruby Ruffle™ Prunus

Prunus persica 'NC Peach-6' PP 34,261

Ruby Ruffle™ Patio Peach gets its name from the ruffled appearance of its leaves and petals. A heavier bloomer than other varieties on the market, this tree flushes with semi-double dark pink flowers every spring and presents dark burgundy foliage that reliably retains its color. The well-behaved habit of this small tree is ideal for small gardens and decorative containers.

FOLIAGE: Burgundy

FLOWER: Deep Pink

HABIT: 4–5' h x 4–5' w

ZONES: 5–8
