MEDIA EC:	1.0–1.5
MOISTURE:	Maintain even moisture in well drained soil.
FERTILIZER:	13-5-9 Harrell's 8–9 month slow release feed, top dressed <ul style="list-style-type: none">• 20 grams in 1 gallon• 40 grams in 2 gallon• 60 grams in 3 gallon
COMMON PESTS & DISEASE:	Watch for spider mites.
TRIMMING:	Recommend one trim minimum during the first year of production to bulk.
PGRS:	None needed
FINISHING TIMES:	• <i>1 gallon:</i> 1 gallon: shift 32c in spring. Plants will be saleable in about 18 months.
